US 41 Project overview

- Largest construction project in the history of Northeast Wisconsin
 - Reconstruct 17 miles in Winnebago County
 - Providing Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) with the project.
 - Providing freeway lighting at key areas to improve safety





US 41 Lake Butte des Morts Crossing

- Replacing 6 existing bridges with 6 new bridges
- New bridges will have aesthetic features
- US 41 will have 8 lanes between WIS 21 and US 45 Interchanges... 4 in each direction
- Constructing virtual weigh-in-motion facility on US 41
- Construction 12' wide multi-modal path with fishing access from Koeller Street on south side to connect to WIOUWASH trail on north side






US 41 Lake Butte des Morts Crossing









US 41/ WIS 21 Interchange 2011 Work

- US 41 Northbound exit ramp and entrance ramp close for 21 days after Labor Day (Southbound ramps and WIS 21 east/west remain open)
- US 41 Southbound structure in Lake Butte des Morts begin construction
- Some grading work on fill areas on WIS 21 (Traffic remains open)





US 41/WIS 21 Interchange 2012 Work


- Interchange closes March 19, 2012
- Detour: WIS 21 to WIS 49 in Berlin to WIS
 91 to WIS 44 to US 41
- Local access provided eastbound WIS 21 to Washburn Street; westbound WIS 21 to Rath Lane





US 41/WIS 21 Interchange 2012 Work

Local Access Map








US 41/WIS 21 Interchange 2012 Work

- Roundabouts at WIS 21/Washburn and WIS 21/Koeller completion June 18, 2012
- US 41 traffic is routed in on east side temporary bypass (similar to US 41/45 Interchange currently)
- Interchange opens November 15, 2012
- Incentive/Disincentive in contract for \$50,000/day up to \$500,000 for 10 days early completion






Roundabouts vs. traffic signals









Roundabouts vs. traffic signals

- Where roundabouts have replaced stop signs and/or traffic signals ...
 - Crashes decreased 39%
 - Injuries decreased 76%
 - Fatalities and/or incapacitating injuries decreased 90%



Crash Types:



9th Avenue and South Washburn Street




Crash Types:

Pedestrian Conflicts: 28








Roundabouts vs. traffic signals

	Traffic signal	Roundabout
Capacity	1	↑
Level of service	1	↑
Traffic speed	Not affected by geometrics	Restrained to 18-30 mph by geometrics
Operational benefits	More delay	Less delay

$$\uparrow$$
 = higher \downarrow = lower







US 41 corridor roundabout plan: engineering, education and enforcement

- Coordination with:
 - Community officials
 - Businesses
 - Affected property owners
 - Public transportation providers
 - Commercial trucking industry
 - Bike and pedestrian stakeholders
- Enforcement of existing traffic laws (yield to pedestrians)
- Appropriately engineered design
- Quality construction
- EDUCATION and OUTREACH





US 41 Traffic management

- Traffic management implementation (2011-2013)
 - Maintain two-lanes NB and SB during construction
 - 55 mph speed limit
 - State Patrol law enforcement
 - Ongoing coordination with public
 - Freeway service team
 - ITS
 - Media outreach, communication and project Web site





Temporary Business Signing

- No signing allowed on freeway or ramps
- Fill out temporary signing permit
- Please try to coordinate together with signing
