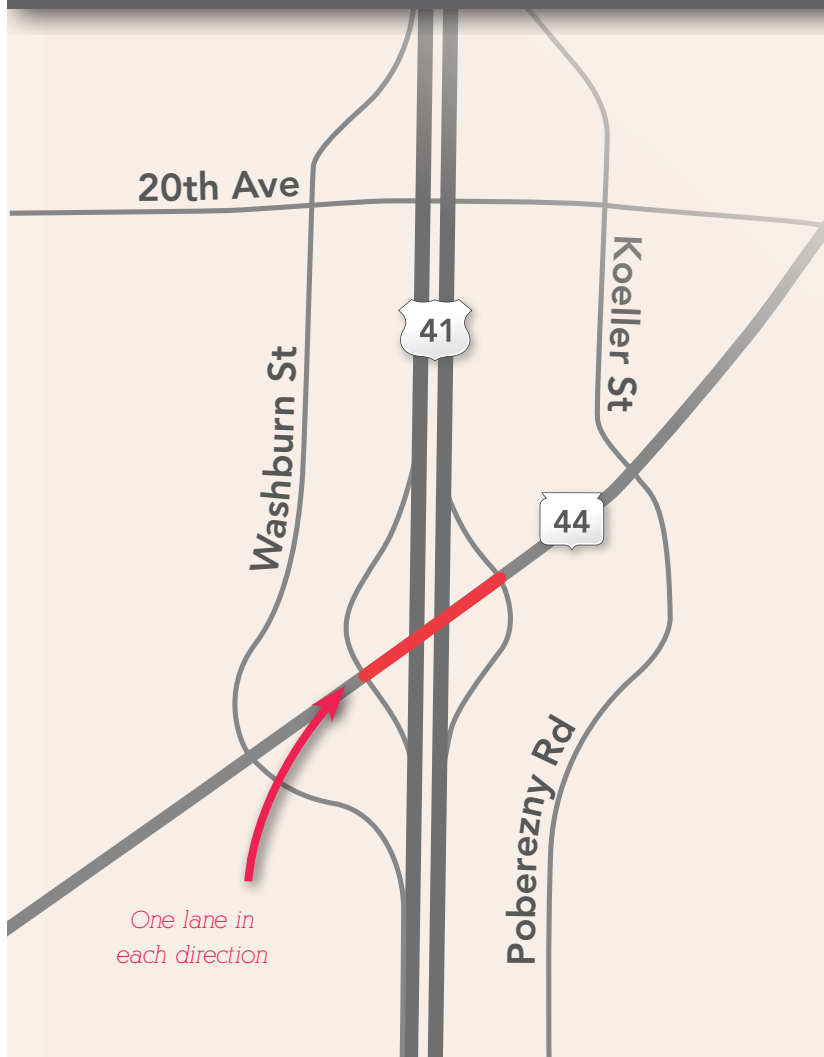


US 41 and WIS 44 Interchange

WIS 44 will be reduced to one lane in each direction



CONSTRUCTION STARTS IN MID APRIL

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing median work will be starting on WIS 44 in April. The purpose of this mailing is to notify you of upcoming traffic impacts on WIS 44, specifically:

- WIS 44 will be reduced to one lane in each direction
- Traffic will be switched to one side of the roadway between the US 41 ramps
- During certain stages, left turns onto US 41 entrance ramps will not be allowed
- Ramps exiting US 41 onto Hwy 44 will be open at all times

This bridge work and approaches will be completed in mid-June. The final landscaping along the WIS 44 median from Washburn to Koeller will be complete by end of October.



WORK INCLUDES:

- Southeast wing of the Hwy 44 over US 41 will be repaired
- Joints and approaches to the bridge will be replaced
- Landscaping and pavement repair
