Guest Speaker:

Stan Mack- Superintendent of Oshkosh Area School District

- 46+ years in education
- 25 years in suburban Twin Cities as assistant or superintendent
- retired from MN schools 3 years ago
- working in regulatory in MN since retiring
- OASD was floundering and kind turned its back on the community
- possible operating referendum in April 2014
- since 1993 Oshkosh schools have been underfunded
- the district has chosen to under levy over the years- which has created a gap between Oshkosh and neighboring communities in programs
- budget reconciliation process
 - committee made up of citizen volunteers and staff
 - understanding of where revenue comes from
 - budget cuts became \$3.9 M
 - revenue programs- cannot be solved with budget cuts
 - 2nd lowest fund balance with similar size districts or surrounding communities
- Project assumptions:
 - 2% base pay increase
 - advancement in steps suspended
 - \$212,000- allocated for teacher credits
- Expenditures:
 - 16M- other expenses
 - 64M- salaries/benefits
 - 3.5 M in cuts- menu of possible reductions
- Committee- drafted letter to the board about a referendum
- \$11M deficient- not fixable in one year- this will be a several year project
